## HRE Rules & Regulations

1. The show will begin at 9 AM, rain or shine.
2. All horses must have current coggins, as well as proof of current flu/rhino vaccination.
3. Proper footwear and ASTM approved helmets are required while mounted.
4. Full show attire is not required, but is recommended.
5. Payment can be made in cash or check only the day of the show. **Checks are made out to Julia Torres.**
6. Any returned check will have an additional \$40 fee.
7. Entries are due the Friday before each show at 7 PM; late entries may be accepted at the discretion of show management but will be subject to a \$5 late fee.
8. A \$25 non showing fee will be applied per horse.
9. Lunging will be permitted in the indoor up until one hour before the start of the show.
10. Schooling breaks of 15 minutes will be permitted between each division.
11. Only riders with back numbers will be permitted to school.
12. All divisions will be placed 1st - 6th, as well as Champion and Reserve Champion.

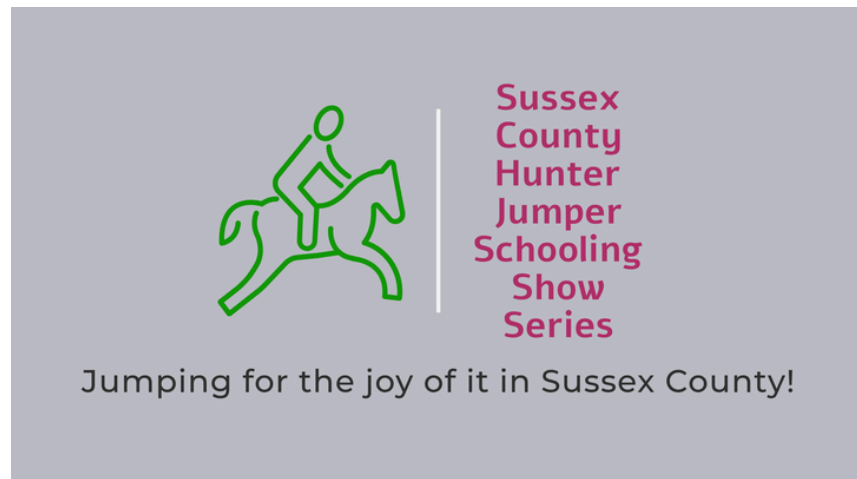
## HRE Series Requirements & Information

**Show Manager: Julia Torres**

- Year end awards will be given to 1st - 4th in each division.
- **Rider (for equitation) or horse (for hunter or jumper) must compete in the same division at three of five shows to be eligible for an HRE Series Championship.**
- There must be at least two entries in each division for the points to be counted.
- HRE series points are awarded as follows: 1st = 10 pts, 2nd = 6 pts, 3rd = 4 pts, 4th = 3 pts, 5th = 2 pts, 6th = 1 pt

## SCHJSSS Series Requirements & Information



*Join the inaugural year of the Sussex County Hunter Jumper Schooling Show Series sponsored by **Four Farthing Farm** in Wantage and **Heavenly Rose Equestrian** in Branchville.*

### **Series rules:**

1. Points will be accrued in the following divisions: Pleasure, Leadline, WT Eq, Beginner Eq, Modified Eq, Open Eq, Baby Green Hunter, Maiden Hunter, Beginner Hunter, Open Hunter, Itty Bitty Jumper
2. Points will be awarded based on this chart:

Placing	Points
1st	10
2 <sup>nd</sup>	6
3 <sup>rd</sup>	4
4 <sup>th</sup>	3
5 <sup>th</sup>	2
6 <sup>th</sup>	1

3. To qualify for an award, you must join the series by June 1, 2024 using a SCHJSSS Membership Form. The entry fee for the year is \$25. However, if a rider wishes to enter in more than 2 divisions, an additional \$25 fee will be applied. Points from 2024 shows prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> will count.
4. Each rider (for Eq divisions) or horse/pony (for H/J divisions) must compete in at least three shows, and at least one show at each sponsor barn, for points to count towards a Year End Award (YEA).
5. Points sheets must be submitted to Lori at FFF no later than October 22, 2024 (1 month after the last show) on the SCHJSSS Placement Reporting Sheet.
6. Both forms are available at the secretary stand of each show.
7. YEA (Ch, RCh, 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>) will be presented at an awards ceremony on a date and at a location to be announced.

# Class Descriptions

## Leadline

Open to riders aged 10 and younger who have never shown in any class other than leadline.

- 1 - Walk on Lead
- 2 - Walk/Trot on lead
- 3 - Walk off lead

## Walk/Trot Equitation 17 & Under

Open to riders aged 17 and younger who have never shown in a class requiring them to canter.

- 4 - Walk/Trot Equitation
- 5 - Walk/Trot Hunter Under Saddle
- 6 - Walk/Trot Pleasure
- 7 - Walk/Trot Poles - shown at the trot over a course of 4 poles on the ground; a half seat should be demonstrated over each pole.

## Walk/Trot Equitation 18 & Over

Open to riders aged 18 and older who have never shown in a class requiring them to canter.

- 8 - Walk/Trot Equitation
- 9 - Walk/Trot Hunter Under Saddle
- 10 - Walk/Trot Pleasure
- 11 - Walk/Trot Poles - shown at the trot over a course of 4 poles on the ground; a half seat should be demonstrated over each pole.

## Pleasure

Open to all horses and ponies.

- 12 - Walk/Trot Pleasure
- 13 - Walk/Trot/Canter Pleasure
- 14 - Country Hack (may be asked to halt, back, and/or hand gallop)

## Baby Green Hunter

Open to all horses/ponies that have not shown over fences prior to the current show year (from 12/31/23).

15 - Walk/Trot Hunter Under Saddle

16 - Walk/Trot Poles - shown at a trot over a course of 4 poles on the ground.

17 - Crossrails - shown at a trot over a line of 2 crossrails.

### **Beginner Equitation**

Open to all child/adult amateur riders who have never shown in any class requiring them to jump more than 18". Trotting on course, including simple changes, is permitted, but an unintentional break of gait will be penalized.

18 - Beginner Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of 4 crossrails.

19 - Beginner Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of 4 crossrails.

20 - Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation

### **Maiden Hunter**

Open to all horses/ponies who have never shown  $\geq 21$ ". To be judged on soundness, manners, and way of going. Trotting on course allowed, but an unintentional break of gait will be penalized. Simple changes are permitted. If there are sufficient entries, the classes will be split between horses and ponies and will be pinned separately.

21 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of 4 crossrails.

22 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of 4 crossrails.

23 - Walk/Trot/Canter Under Saddle

### **Modified Equitation**

Open to all child/adult amateur riders who have never shown in any class requiring them to jump  $> 21$ ". No oxers or combinations. Simple changes permitted.

24 - Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 18" verticals.

25 - Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 18" verticals.

26 - Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation

### **Beginner Hunter**

Open to all horses/ponies who have never shown  $> 21$ ". To be judged on soundness, manners, and way of going. Trotting on course allowed, but an unintentional break of gait will be penalized. Simple changes permitted. No oxers or combinations permitted.

27 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 18" verticals.

28 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 18" verticals.

29 - Walk/Trot/Canter Under Saddle

### **Open Equitation**

Open to all child/adult amateur riders who have never shown in any class requiring them to jump > 2'3". No oxers or combinations. Simple changes permitted.

30 - Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 2'-2'3" verticals with one change of direction.

31 - Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 2'-2'3" verticals with one change of direction.

32 - Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation

### **Open Hunter**

Open all horses/ponies who have never shown >2'3". To be judged on soundness, manners, and way of going. Simple changes are permitted. Oxers up to 18" spreads permitted. No combinations.

33 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of 8 verticals with at least one change of direction; horses to show at 2'-2'3" and ponies at 18".

34 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of 8 verticals with at least one change of direction; horses to show at 2'-2'3" and ponies at 18".

35 - Walk/Trot/Canter Under Saddle

### **Itty Bitty Jumpers**

Open to all horses/ponies and riders. Height 2'-2'3" with oxers up to 2' spread. Combinations permitted.

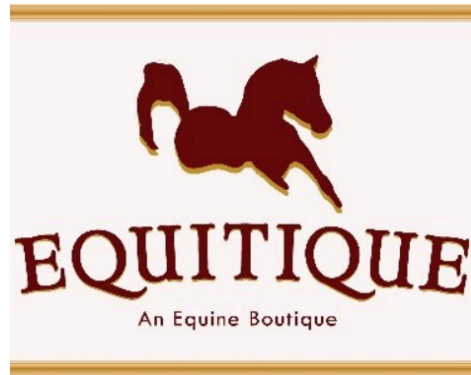
36-38 - Fences - A minimum of 8 jumps per class with a jump off over a shortened course of fences for each clear round.
