HRE Rules & Regulations

1. The show will begin at 9 AM, rain or shine.
2. All horses must have current coggins, as well as proof of current flu/rhino vaccination.
3. Proper footwear and ASTM approved helmets are required while mounted.
4. Full show attire is not required, but is recommended.
5. Payment can be made in cash or check only the day of the show. **Checks are made out to Julia Torres.**
6. Any returned check will have an additional \$40 fee.
7. Entries are due the Friday before each show at 7 PM; late entries may be accepted at the discretion of show management but will be subject to a \$5 late fee.
8. A \$25 non showing fee will be applied per horse.
9. Lunging will be permitted in the indoor up until one hour before the start of the show.
10. Schooling breaks of 15 minutes will be permitted between each division.
11. Only riders with back numbers will be permitted to school.
12. All divisions will be placed 1st - 6th, as well as Champion and Reserve Champion.

HRE Series Requirements & Information

- Year end awards will be given to Champion and Reserve Champion in each division.
- **Rider (for equitation) or horse (for hunter or jumper) must compete in the same division at two of three shows to be eligible for an HRE Series Championship.**
- There must be at least two entries in each division for the points to be counted.
- HRE series points are awarded as follows: 1st = 7 pts, 2nd = 5 pts, 3rd = 4 pts, 4th = 3 pts, 5th = 2 pts, 6th = 1 pt

Class Descriptions

Leadline

Open to riders aged 10 and younger who have never shown in any class other than leadline.

- 1 - Walk on lead
- 2 - Walk/Trot on lead
- 3 - Walk off lead

Walk/Trot Equitation 17 & Under

Open to riders aged 17 and younger who have never shown in a class requiring them to canter.

- 4 - Walk/Trot Equitation
- 5 - Walk/Trot Hunter Under Saddle
- 6 - Walk/Trot Pleasure

Walk/Trot Equitation 18 & Over

Open to riders aged 18 and older who have never shown in a class requiring them to canter.

- 7 - Walk/Trot Equitation
- 8 - Walk/Trot Hunter Under Saddle
- 9 - Walk/Trot Pleasure

Pleasure

Open to all horses and ponies.

- 10 - Walk/Trot/Canter
- 11 - Walk/Trot/Canter
- 12 - Country Hack (may be asked to halt, back, and/or hand gallop)

Green Hunter Horse

Open to all horses/ponies in their first two years of showing, regardless of age. To be judged on soundness, manners, and way of going.

- 13 - Walk/Trot Hunter Under Saddle
- 14 - Walk/Trot/Individual Canter Hunter Under Saddle
- 15 - Crossrails - shown over a line of 2 crossrails. Horses may trot or canter.

Beginner Rider Equitation

Open to all child/adult amateur riders who have never shown in any class requiring them to jump greater than 18". Trotting on course, including simple changes, is permitted, but an unintentional break of gait will be penalized.

- 16 - Walk/Trot Equitation
- 17 - Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation
- 18 - Beginner Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of 8 crossrails.
- 19 - Beginner Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of 8 crossrails.

Maiden Hunter

Open to all horses/ponies who have never shown greater than 18". To be judged on soundness, manners, and way of going. Trotting on course, including simple changes, is permitted, but an unintentional break of gait will be penalized.

- 20 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight crossrails.
- 21 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight crossrails.

22 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of four crossrails.

23 - Walk/Trot/Canter Hunter Under Saddle

Beginner Hunter

Open to all horses/adult ponies who have never shown in any class requiring them to jump greater than 2'. Trotting on course allowed, but an unintentional break of gait will be penalized

No oxers or combinations. Simple changes are permitted.

24 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 18" verticals.

25 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 18" verticals.

26 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 18" verticals.

27 - Walk/Trot/Canter Hunter Under Saddle

Pre-Modified Equitation

Open to all riders who have never shown greater than 2'3". Simple changes are permitted.

Course will contain oxers.

28 - Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 2' jumps.

29 - Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 2' jumps.

30 - Equitation Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 2' jumps.

31 - Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation

Hopeful Hunters

Open to all horses/ponies who have never shown greater than 2'3". Simple changes are permitted. Course will contain oxers.

32 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 2' jumps.

33 - Hunter Over Fences - shown over a course of eight 2' jumps.
